

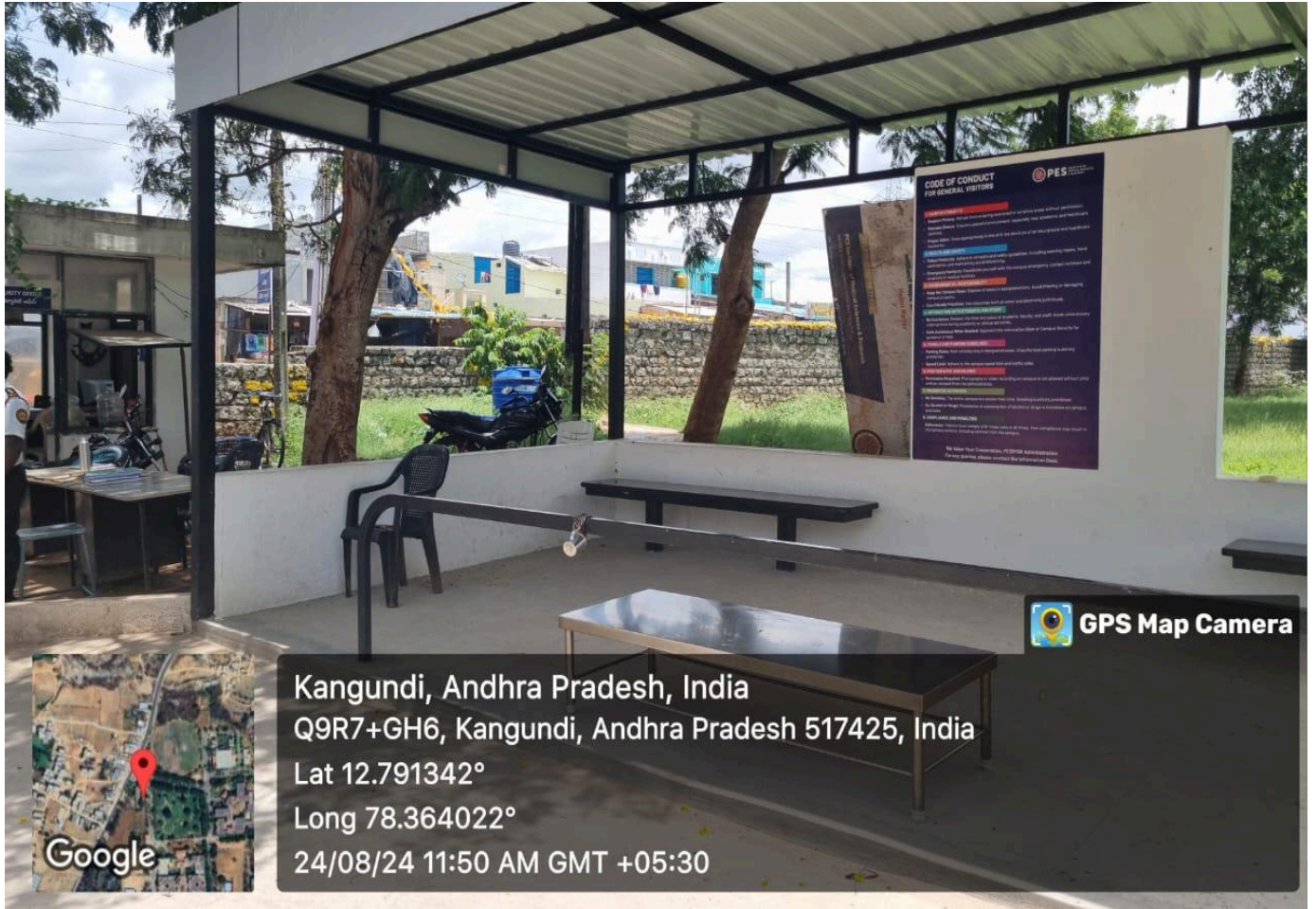



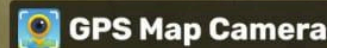
- 1. ACADEMIC INTEGRITY**
  - **Attend Classes Regularly:** Attendance is mandatory for all classes. Students must maintain a minimum of 80% attendance in each subject.

  - **Plagiarism:** All assignments, reports, and projects should be the original work of the student. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited.
- 2. GENERAL DISCIPLINE**

## Code of conduct for patient attendees



**CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PATIENT ATTENDEES**

## Code of conduct for visitors near critical units



**CODE OF CONDUCT FOR VISITORS NEAR CRITICAL UNITS**

**WELCOME TO PESIMS, Request Denial**  
At PESIMS, we prioritize the safety, health, and comfort of our patients. As a visitor near critical care units, we kindly ask you to adhere to the following code of conduct to ensure a secure and safe environment for everyone.

**1. VISITING HOURS:**  
Please adhere strictly to the visiting hours. No visitors are allowed outside the specified time slots unless authorized by the medical staff.

**2. VISITOR RESTRICTIONS:**  
Only two visitors per patient are allowed at any time. Children below 10 years are not permitted in critical care areas.

**3. MOBILE PHONE POLICY:**  
Please silence all phones. Turn off or keep mobile phones on silent mode to avoid disturbing patients.

**4. PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**  
Wash hands with sanitizer or soap before and after visiting the patient.  
Wear protective gear such as masks or gowns as required by the medical staff.  
Avoid touching medical equipment, patient beds, or surfaces unnecessarily.


**5. PATIENT WELL-BEING:**  
Visitors with symptoms of cough, flu, or any contagious disease are advised not to visit critical care areas.  
If you feel unwell during your visit, please inform the staff immediately.

**6. SAFETY PROTOCOLS:**  
Do not bring any food or beverages into critical care units unless approved by the healthcare staff.
