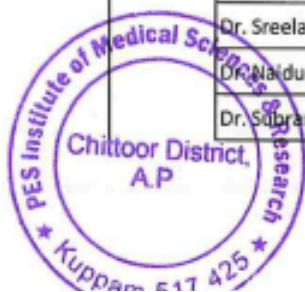

The Principal is further informed to make a note of the following:

- In 2019-20, 63 proposals have been submitted to the University for Registration. The details of pending topics of 2019-20, if any, should be sent immediately for registration duly explaining the reasons for late submission.
- The pending topics if any, in respect of the students admitted prior to 2019-20 may also be sent to University for registration duly explaining the reasons for late submission.
- Each topic of a student should be recommended by HOD and to be forwarded by Principal.
- While selecting topics for dissertation, the HOD should ensure that topics selected in the previous 05 years are avoided. For this purpose, the data of the topics registered by all the PG students for the academic years 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19 are made available in the website of this University. In case of any repetition of the topics, the concerned Principal / HOD will be held responsible.
