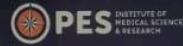

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CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS



1. ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

6. HEALTH AND SAFETY

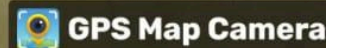
- Medical Assistance: In case of any health issues, students should immediately report to the campus medical center.

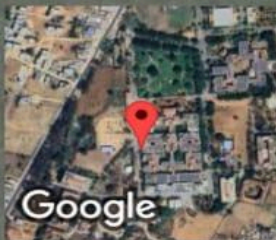

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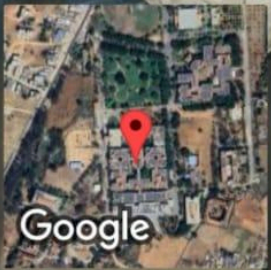
CODE OF CONDUCT FOR VISITORS NEAR CRITICAL UNITS

At PESIMS, we promise the safety, health, and comfort of our patients. As a visitor near critical care units, we kindly ask you to adhere to the following code of conduct to ensure a secure and safe environment for everyone.

- 1. VISITING HOURS:** Please adhere strictly to the visiting hours. No visitors are allowed outside the specified time slots unless authorized by the medical staff.
- 2. VISITOR LIMITS:** Only four visitors per patient are allowed at any time. Children below 12 years are not permitted in critical care areas.
- 3. MOBILE PHONE POLICY:** Please silence all phones. Turn off or keep mobile phones on silent mode to avoid disturbing patients.
- 4. PERSONAL HYGIENE:** Wash hands with sanitizer or soap before and after visiting the patient. Wear protective gear (mask or gloves) as required by the medical staff. Avoid touching medical equipment, patient beds, or surfaces unnecessarily.
- 5. HEALTH SCREENING:**
 - Visitors with symptoms of cough, flu, or any contagious disease are advised not to visit critical care areas.
 - If you feel unwell during your visit, please inform the staff immediately.
- 6. NO ENTRY OR REMOVAL:** Do not bring any food or beverages into critical care units unless approved by the healthcare staff.
- 7. NO PHOTOGRAPHY:** No cameras, mobile phones, or recording devices are allowed in critical care areas to protect infections. Do not photograph or record patients, staff, or any medical equipment without prior permission.
- 8. EMERGENCY PROCEDURE:** In case of an emergency, follow the instructions provided by the healthcare staff. Do not panic or interfere with medical procedures.
- 9. VISITATION POLICY:** Please communicate with patients kindly and softly. Extended conversations may limit or disrupt their rest.
